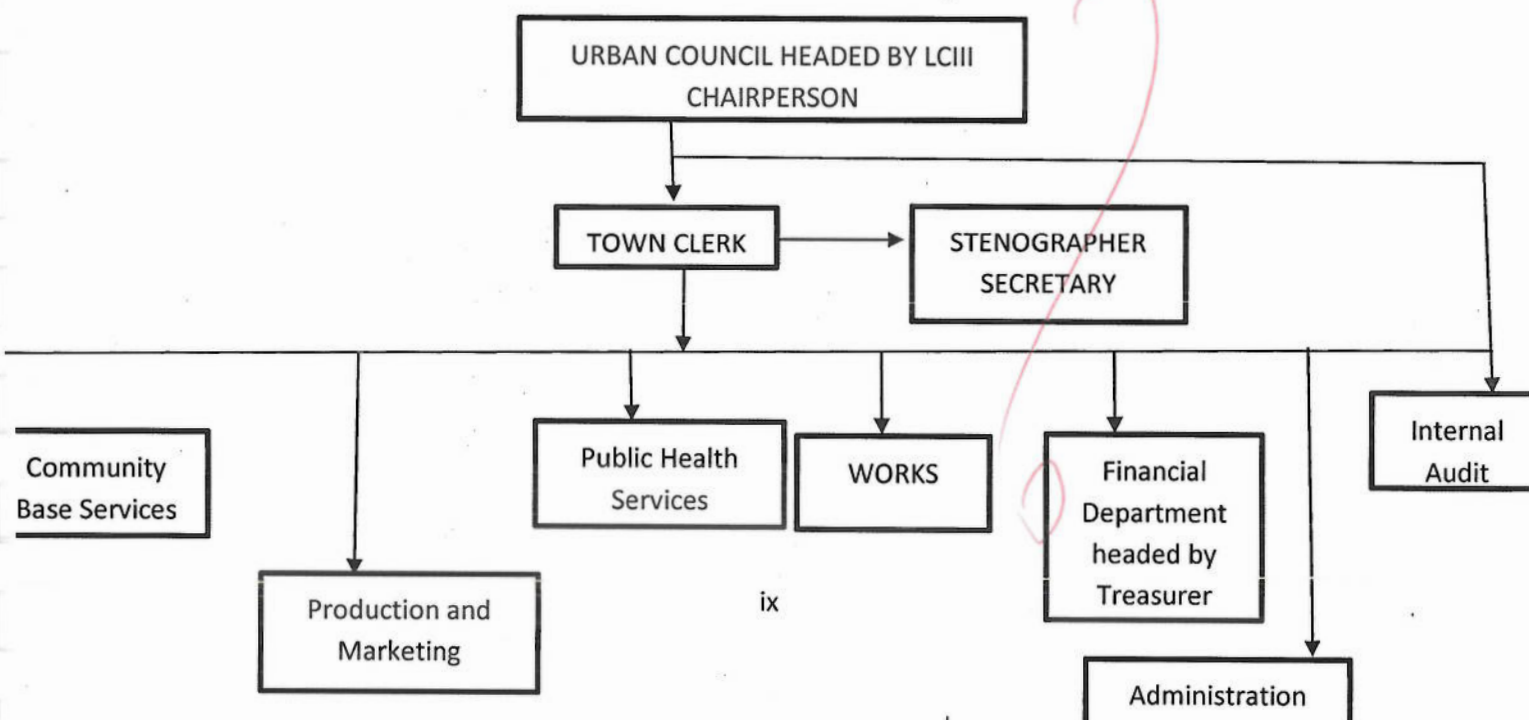

1.3 LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION OF THE ATTACHMENT

It is located 525km from kampala and it is linked to towns, Yumbe in the south-west and Adjumani in the southeast by main trunk roads of 75km and 40km respectively. It is also linked to kajokeji in the north and Nimule in the northeast (both are towns across the international border in south sudan)
