ABSTRACT

The IT was carried out at AMELIA AGRO AFRICA LTD in Naminya sub county, Buikwe district for eight weeks that's from 28th FEBRUARY -22nd APRIL 2022 mainly on crop and animal al production.

Objectives of the IT was to enable students to acquire skills in relation to the theory learnt in class about management of crops, animals and other agribusiness activities, to enable students interact with people of different categories like managers, supervisors , farmers and other workers.
