ABSTRACT

The internship training was conducted at Bumbo town council, Namisindwa district local government for a period of ten weeks from 28th Feb, 2022 to 6th, May, 2022. The purpose of this training was to equip students with practical skills that are relevant to their respective courses especially in animal production and management, during the ten weeks period many activities were under taken and these included castration, orientation, dehorning, dehorning, spraying, pasture conservation, poultry vaccination, vaccination of cattle against FMD, vaccination pets against Rabies, meat inspection, feed mixing, disease diagnosis and treatment, animal traction. Many challenges were encountered during the internship period such as bad weather condition, language barrier, failure to issue work plan in time, tiresome work done and transport costs to the farm. However, it was concluded that the industrial training was successfully carried out however some challenges where encountered such as bad weather, failure to issue the work plan in time, language barrier and inadequate labor. In recommendation therefore the organization should recruit other workers because work was tiresome due to inadequate labor personnel.

CHAPTER ONE; INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the town council

Bumbo town council local government was established in July 2019 containing 11 wards which are Mukhuyu, Laaso, Busubende, Bumbo town, Bukisasati, saboti, Iwanda, sirekere, Tsebumbeyi, Lulangatsi and Namwenula. It takes off during the first quarter of financial year 2019/2020 with small number of employees with expanded assignments. It started very well after the renovation of existing structures formerly for Bumbo sub county headquarters.

1.2. Geographical location of the organization

Bumbo town council is found eastern part of Namisindwa district in eastern Uganda. It's found with latitude of 0.8617° and longitude of 34.3924° and open location code of 6GGPV96R+MW found. Its bordered by Magale town council in the west, Bumwoni sub county in the south Bukokho in the east and Bumbo sub county in the north.

1.3. Political and administrative infrastructure

The Town council is under the political leadership of the mayor who heads the governing council and the Executives. The Council is the sole decision making body for the town council and its decisions are implemented by the Technical Planning Committee staff from various disciplines headed by the town Clark. There are 2 Sectorial committees of the council each headed by a secretary (executive) namely; Production, Works and Technical Services Committee and Finance, Planning, Administration and Community Services Committee.
