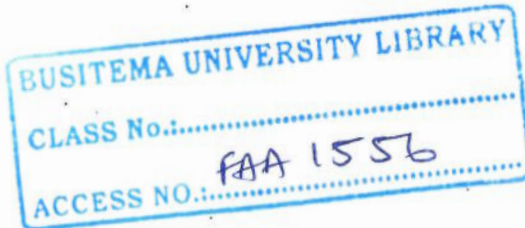

ABSTRACT

Industrial training is one of the University programmes whereby at the end of the first year each student is required to go out for the training. The training has to combine the knowledge obtained in class with the one obtained from the field. This training was done at the production and marketing department Lira District Local Government where the work covers the whole Lira District for two and half Month. The practice was supervised by different doctors of the District according to the department. The various activities carried out, on the day there was orientation induction training with the various staffs of the District, followed by meat inspection for three weeks; findings were that liver flukes is still a problem at the District, oesophagostomum in goats and worms. We were to identify the three farmers of different enterprise, that is to say dairy and piggery, where we attended for two weeks each during advising them on good management practice. During the training vaccination of ECF and trypanosomosis in Lira District meat inspection.

CHAPTER ONE

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Lira District Local Government Production and Marketing Department is made up of six sectors of; crops, livestock, entomology,, commercial fisheries and operational wealth creation. The department is headed by Dr. William Okwir who is the DPMO assisted by head of sectors. The approved structures provide for technical extension workers eight (8) for crop and six for six for livestock in the field. The department has the following support staffs at the district level i.e. accountant, office attendant, department secretary and the drivers.

1.1 HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF THE ORGANIZATION

Lira district was formed in 1974. The district is occupied mostly by the Langi tribe which was originally known as Lango but it was later on divided into east and west and later Lira and Apac districts. Today, the district has created more four districts which are; - Otuke, Alebtong, Dokolo and Amolafar. The langi are the Luo speaking people who are believed to have come from Ethiopia and are considered to be part of the nilo hamites which includes kumam, itesots and karamojong tribes. The langi before British administration from 1890 splited in to many groups under different tenernship and British administration dates back in 1900. In the early days, it was in the hands of Buganda agent and the present day district was established in 1914.

Lira district local government has nine sub counties operating under it are Amach, Ogur, Ngetta, Agweng, Aromo, Agali, Adekokwok, Bar and Lira sub counties. Lira district local government has many departments that operate under it as production, health, works and technical services and national resource, education and community based services which make the normal functioning of the district.
