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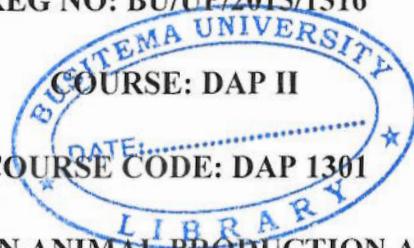

## ABSTRACT

Internship is an important component of Agricultural production in East and entire country that provides majority students the access to practice what they learnt during theory in their lecture. The training commenced on 16<sup>th</sup>/May/2016 to 22<sup>rd</sup>/July/2016. It was essential in improving the learning culture of students of higher learning institutes.

Several studies were taken by intern students under the guidance of Mr. Mutume Tito to establish suitable environment for learners under the following sections; Animal section which involved cattle, goats, rabbits, pigs, fish and bees. And crop section involved carrots, egg plants, water melon, tomatoes and cereals like maize. Many activities were undertaken in both sections like daily management of animal section .e.g. feeding, watering, disease diagnosis Disease identification in crops, although such initiatives are there in place, strong and dynamic strategy for will sustain learner's careers.
