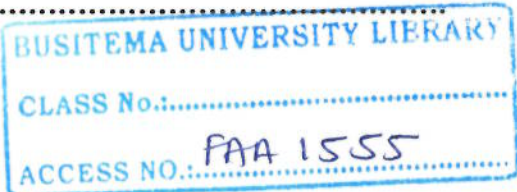

ABSTRACT

This field attachment training has been carried out at alebtong district under department of production and marketing for a period of about three months .the district is situated in lango-sub region northern Uganda and it is bordered by four district of LIRA, AMURIA DOKOLO and OTUKE. The District headquarter is located approximately 48km by road task of lira district **28km** by road north of Kampala which is the capital city of Uganda, the coordinates of the district are 02.18N and 33.8E.

The district was created and become operational on the 1st July2010 and now it has 8 sub-counties of omoro, abako, Alooi, Awei, Amugu, abia, and Apala sub-county. The demography of the distrrict in 1991 was 12600 and in 2012 it was 22600.

On the other hand the training has help me transforming theoretical knowledge in to practical knowledge, acquisition of leadership skills and record keeping.
