EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report outlines the major purpose of the internship program as part of a student's way of implementing what is theoretically taught in class to relate it in the working environment. It assesses the relatedness of this program to the courses taught at university and its relevance to the student. The internship training was conducted from 1ST March to 10^{SS}TH May 2022 at Kufarm diverse agriculture Wakiso Namusera along Hoima road.
