1.1 Location and description of place of field attachment

1.1 Location of Pallisa town council

PTC is positioned in the Eastern region of Uganda in Pallisa district; its headquarters liesadjacent to the Pallisa district Local Government offices. It is positioned 190km Northeast of the Capital City Kampala, 50kms West of the Regional city Mbale. It is 5km North of Lake Lemwa, 100kms South of Soroti International Airport.It is bordered by Serere and Kumi districts in the NorthEast,Ngora in the North, Butebo, Kibuku and Budaka Districts in the East.It lies astride latitudes 1:45°N and 1:05°S and between longitudes 33:47°E and 34:05°W with an area coverage of 32.4 square kilometers. 1.1 Description of place of field attachment

Pallisa Town Council is headed politically by the LC III (Mayor) this is followed by the Town Clerk (TC) who is the Senior Accounting Officer of Pallisa Town Council. It is composed of ten programs that to say management and support service, finance and planning, education and sports, works and technical service, statutory bodies, production, health and environment natural resources gender and community services and internal audit and it is also assisted by sixteen sub programs that help it on its performance. Pallisa town council is composed of five wards and thirty eight cells with a population of thirty five people and 4,717 households as seen in the table below.
