1:0 INTRODUCTION

1.1: Loaction and description of the place of field attachment

This guide is to provide an overview of the internship programme and highlights the objectives of the internship programme, roles of the supervisors and the expectation of the student during the internship programme.

Pallisa district local government

Pallisa district local government is located along Gongonyo Road Pallisa town council; the district has along historical trend which resulted into its creation. It was curved out of Tororo district (former Bukedi district). This happened on 13th march 1999 before Tororo was disintegrated into Busia and Butaleja district respectively. However, it is noted that Pallisa had acquired a district status as early as 1976 as north Bukedi district but this was retained in 1979 immediately after the liberation war.

The transformation of Budaka County in to a district status on 1st July 2006 changed the geographical and demographic set up to present size and the Kampala, Mbale-Tirinyi Pallisa highway.

The geographical area of the district is 1625sq.km of which 338kmsq.km is covered by wetlands, rivers, and lakes. The district is composed of the following counties namely; Agule, Butebo and Pallisa.

The district is divided in to 19 sub-counties, 1 town council and 5 town boards (Petete, Butebo, Kakoro, Kaboloi and Kabwangasi) there are 85 parishes and 545 villages.
