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ABSTRACT

This research proposal provides an insight on the influence of Mother Tongue on the Speaking and Learning of English Language. CHAPTER ONE

1.0 Introduction

This chapter aims at introducing the background of the study, problem statement, objectives of the study, research questions, and scope of the study and significance of the study.

1.1Background of the study

Mother Tongue is the language that one first learns to speak when they are young (Hornby, 1993, p. 956). As noted by Ashwoth (1992), Mother Tongue or native language is a language which a person acquires in early years and which normally becomes their natural instrument of thought and communication and eventually makes the learning of the second language difficult. When an individual is fluent in mother tongue, it can be concluded that the individual is knowledgeable and all knowledge, including all other qualities of a person that arise from education, are due to the environment (Akinpelu, 1982, p. 70). Mother tongue probably has some influence on the acquisition of the second language, which is English for this case. Ashworth (1992) observes that the second language is a language acquired by a person in addition to their mother tongue.

1.2 Problem statement

Learners have problems in learning English language (L2) which affects them in speaking and learning. Despite the fact that many of them are not perfect in speaking mother tongue (L1), they have difficulties in pronunciations, sentence construction of English words.
