

## ABSTRACT

### 1.0: INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 Background of Apeduru Sub County

Apeduru subcounty is one of the lower local governments in Amuria district. It's located on the eastern direction from Amuria district local government headquarters approximately 07km along Acowa kapelebiong road. The subcounty was carved from Asamuk subcounty in the year 2011. The subcounty is bordered by five subcounties i.e. Amuria town council on the western, Willa on the North West, Akoromit on the east, and Asamuk on the southern direction. The subcounty has clay-loamy/sandy-loamy soils that support variety of annual, bi-annual and perennial crops. The vegetation is mainly of tall grasses with dotted trees which is the characteristic of savanna grass land. A result from geographical survey and water drilling has it that most areas from the subcounty do not have any mineral potential. Some areas in the subcounty are rocky specifically in Ajaki parish but minimal and there for do not support agriculture. The subcounty is also endowed with water ways and streams that surrounds the subcounty and are supportive to the community. It has departments under which it operates for example Production, Finance, Community service and Administration sector. The organization carries out service delivery to the target community which in this regard is the community of Apeduru S/C.
