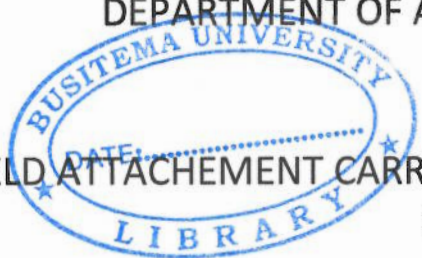

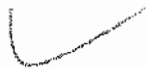
ABSTRACT

1.1 Background of the organization:

Uganda Prisons Soroti started in 1956 as government farm prison for production of cotton, with 13 staffs and 76 male inmates headed by principal officer one Mr.; Ekwang Daniel.

It had one ward for inmates and 15 in pot houses for the staffs.

In 1997 due to gradual increase of criminals; the population rose to 350-400 inmates.

In 2000, the government opened female prison section in maximum organization to be headed by officer in charge Mrs. Mbabazi Lilian with eight women staffs and 23 women inmates.

Location of the organization: Moroto road /highway.
