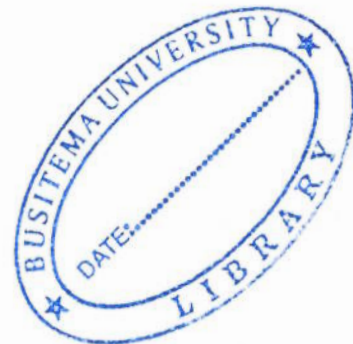



## ABSTRACT
