#### ABSTRACT

The industrial training report is a combination of all the activities undertaken during the industrial training period in Kortek s/c Bukwo district local Government, Bukwo district is one of the districts in eastern Uganda; it's bordered by Kenya to the east, Mount Elgon Nation Park to the south, Amudat district to the north and Kween district to the west. The most predominant tribe is the sabinys who do practice livestock rearing and cultivating of crops. During my IT was attached to the production sector under the supervision of DPO and under him was the extension workers and I was introduced to many activities among which were NCD sensitization and vaccination, pasture training and establishment, meat inspection, disease diagnosis and treatment such ECF, black quarter, assessing NUSAF cows and handing over to farmers, monitoring government technologies and farmer trainings, with such activities I obtained skills on disease diagnosis, preventive medicine, drug administration, farmer trainings and monitoring and evaluation. This IT has exposed me to the word of hands activities which is a product of class room learning and has opened my eyes widely to the world since such exposure builds confidence makes work easy. However there were some challenges, the area was hilly which made movement hard, some farmers wanted facilitation before attending trainings, some farmers were so conservative and also the transport system was so poor. Recommendations' local council ones should sensitize their people on importance of production trainings, construction of durable working roads to ease access to hard to reach area to ensure uniform technology adoption in the s/c

### **CHAPTER ONE: INTRODUCTION**

The field training was carried out in Bukwo district local government, Kortek sub-county, under production department came to an end successfully. Bukwo district is in the far east of Uganda bordered by Kenya to the east, Kween district to the west, Amudat to the North and Mount Elgon

National park to the south. It is inhabited by sabinys whose main economic activity is growing of crops and rearing of livestock like cattle, sheep, poultry, and goats among others.

The sector offers services like veterinary. Trainings on livestock husbandry, distribution of quality livestock breeds and crops among others and this have helped farmers to improve in the sector thus improving the economy though the sector still registers weaknesses.

#### 1.2 History of Kortek Sub-County

Kortek sub-county is one of the twelve sub-counties of Bukwo district, it was founded in 2012 but it was then under Kabei sub-county. It's located in the slopes of Mount Elgon 5km away from kapchorwa –Suam road and it borders Kabei s/c to the North, Chepkwasta s/c to the east, Mount Elgon national park to south and Kabei sub-county to the west. The sub-county is endowed with fertile volcanic soils which has favored the growth of ever green Tropical and mountain vegetation that supports long term production of livestock, has good climate for agriculture and the inhabitants practice Montana type of agriculture involving intercropping of both maize, beans, bananas and livestock production
