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ABSTRACT

The industrial training was done for 10 weeks starting on 28th Feb 2022 to 7th May 2022. It was carried out in Rwentobo-Rwahi town council. Ntungamo district located on Kabale-Mbarara Highway32 kilometers, in southwestern Uganda

The training was aimed at equipping the student with practical knowledge and relating it with the theory obtained in lectures. Activities that were earried out during the industrial training included; deworming using injectable dewormers, vaccination of viral diseases especially lumpy skin disease, foot and mouth disease in cattle, and Rabies in Pets, treatment of diseases for example Mastitis, protozoan diseases, training of farmers about acaricides, ticks and tick borne diseases, among others

I gained skills in the activities like diagnosing the cardinal signs of the various diseases and their treatment, vaccinating of viral diseases and farm husbandry practices and took the following responsibilities during the internship vaccination, farmer trainings and assuming official responsibilities

The challenges faced were; absence of primary structures like crushes on some farms which made my work tiresome, sickness as a result of malaria and flue during the course of my internship, conservative farmers who were resisting vaccination of their cattle, insufficient funds for transport to move around the whole the town council attending to farmers. I managed to solve some challenges like Mularia fever, transportation to the farms by hiring motorcycles but other challenges were to be handled by farmers and local government. In conclusion, the industrial training was successful and my objectives were also achieved for example putting the theories I got from lectures into practice. I recommend the local government to facilitate veterinarians with reliable transport means to the field, farmers to construct primary farm structures like crushes and the university to restock the animals on the farm and all necessary equipments so as the students enjoy hands on activities straight away from the campus.

CHAPTER ONE:

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Back ground information

Industrial training was conducted in Rwentobo-Rwahi town council located 32km on Kabale-Mbarara highway from Ntungamo town. Ntungamo district with the Department of Production. Veterinary sector under the overall supervision of the District veterinary Officer. The District is located in southwestern Uganda, between 00 53S, 30 16E. The district covers 2051.4km² and approximately 0.2% is open water, 3.4% is wetland and about 0.01% is forest. It's bordered to the north by Mitooma district, Sheema and Mbarara going from west to east, Isingiro district lies to the east, the Republic of Rwanda to the south. Kabale district to the southwest and Rukungiri to the northwest.
