ABSTRACT

APM 2301, industrial training and community out reach is one of the course unit offered by Busitema University to every student pursuing bachelor of animal production and management. It is the course unit that provide the student with significant skills and practical knowledge and motivates him or her to become a professional and successfulin his or hercareer. The student gains both the theoretical and practical knowledge during the training. This report covers the introductory part detailing the description of Ochero town council as the study area where the industrial was carried out from. It also contains the details of all the activities conducted during the period of industrial training in the town council of Ochero in Kaberamaido District. The activities conducted centered purely on animal husbandry e.g. herd health inspection, disease surveillance, and Animalhealth certification/issuance of animal movement permits, demonstration on tick control and poultry vaccination. The most prevalent animal diseases discovered in the field were majorly tick borne diseases, fasciolaisis and trypanosomosis. Sick animals were treated by me under the supervision of my field supervisor. The community of Ochero town council enjoyed consumption of safe and quality meat as the carcasses of all slaughtered animals were thoroughly inspected. The administration of Ochero town council is advised to put right the fence in the kraal which has already collapsed. Control of entry and exit of livestock will be easy once the new fencing is put in place.

Introduction

1.1 Background of Ochero Town Council Local Government as the study area;

The industrial training which ran for a period of ten weeks was conducted from Ochero Town Council in Kaberamaido district.

Geographically, Kaberamaido district is located in Eastern Uganda. Kaberamaido district was curved out of Soroti district in 2001. It is bordered to the South West by Amolatar district, to the North and West by Dokolo district, East by Amuria and South by Soroti and Serere districts as well as Lake Kyoga. Kaberamaido district consists of 11 sub-counties with two town council as well making a total of 13 Lower Local Administrative Units of Government.

Ochero Town Council was the main study area. The Town Council of Ochero is formally demarcated from Ochero Sub-County and comprised of three wards namely Kagaa with 3 cells, Omodoi with 3 cells and Okeratok with 3 cells. The administrative structure of Ochero Town Council Local Government is such that the Ag. Town Clerk is the head of the technical staff in the Town Council. The other technical officers include the Veterinary Officer (V.O), Community Development Officer (CDO), Sub Accountant, Town Agents, Office Secretary and a compound cleaner. Under NAADS, the Agricultural Advisory Service Providers supervised by the Town Council NAADS Coordinator used to train farmers on improved and modern animal and crop production and management. But NAADS was disbanded by the President of the Republic of Uganda, H.E. YoweriMuseveni and has since been renamed Operation Wealth Creation which is
