CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

The report mainly looks at the period of internship training that was undertaken at Lamwo District Local Government which is located in Northern Uganda. The report also includes different activities engaged in during the time of internship from the period of 28th February to the 24th April 2022.

1.1. Back ground of the organization.

The district was curved out of Kitgum and it came into effect on the 1st -11 -2010. Its bordered by South Sudan to the North, Kitgum district to the East and South East, Pader district to the South Gulu District to the South West, and Amuru district to the West. Lamwo district has a total area of 241,551 square kilometers, of which land area covers 200,523 square kilometers. According to the population housing census.

1.2 Location.

The town of Lamwo is approximately 26 kilometers (17mi), by road, north west of Kitgum, the nearest large town. This is approximately 150 kilometers (93 mi), by road, north east of Gulu the largest city in the Acholi sub region. The coordinates of Lamwo district, Uganda are Latitude: 3°31'59.99" N Longitude: 32°47'59.99" E.

1.3 Population

According to the population census of 12th -01-1991 the population was at 71,030 on the 13th -09-2002 it was at 115,345 and on the 27th -08-2014 it was at 134,371. The population projection by 01st -07-2020 by Uganda Bureau of Statistic was 143,800.
