



I carried out my industrial training at Arua district local government under the department of production and marketing (veterinary department)



1.0 INTRODUCTION

Industrial training is one of the modules with the code DAP1301 for the award of diploma in animal production and management and other programs like CGA, DCP, APM, DAP, BAS, AGB in faculty of agriculture and animal sciences, Busitema university. The training was carried out at Arua district local government under the department of production and marketing (veterinary department) for the period of 10 weeks from 28th.feb.2022 to 6th.may.2022

1.1 HISTORY OF ARUA DISTRICT,

Arua is one of the iii district of the republic of Uganda and one of the 8 district of the West Nile sub regions, Arua District was curved out of them West Nile and Madi District which was founded in 1912 during the colonial period.

In 1953 Madi District comprising of the current Moyo and Ajumani districts was granted a district status leaving west Nile as a district.

In 1973, West Nile was given a provincial status but reverted back to a district in 1979 with Nebbi been curved in to a district of its own.

Arua district got its name from Arua town. In 1979 when the Ugandan president at the time of Godfrey Binaisa declared that all districts/provinces acquire their name from their regional capital so, that is how Arua district inherited the name from Arua town.

In 2001 Yumbe district was curved out of Aringa county of Arua district. Koboko district was similarly curved out of Koboko county of Arua district.

In 2006 a district comprising of the counties, of Maracha and Terego was curved out Arua through its political organs were not operational due to failure to resolve on the location of the district headquarters. In 2010 Maracha district was curved out of Maracha County. Terego from Terego County. Madi okollo from Madi Okollo County. Arua district as of now comprises of the counties of Arua municipality, Ayivu, Vurra.



1.2 BACKGROUND

Arua district is a district in the northern region of Uganda. Like many other Ugandan districts, it shares its name with its administrative center of Arua. The name Arua is said to be derived from the lugbara name for prison (Arujo) and prisoner (Aru), since the white settlers (Belgians and later British) had a detention center at Arua hill
