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

1.1. BACKGROUND OF SOROTI CITY COUNCIL

Soroti City is one of the main Commercial and Administrative City in Eastern Region of Uganda. Soroti City owes its origin to the establishment of Kakungulu's Camp near Solot Rock as an Administrative Post to oversee Serere, Gweri and Soroti areas as directed by the District Commissioner, Mbale. The choice of this site was influenced by the availability of good water from the streams and the rock was good for defense purposes against possible attacks from locals around. Under the able rule of Semei Kakungulu, there was a considerable settlement in the area after forcefully clearing the forests using the locals.

In 1912, Sir Fredrick Jackson as new Governor, recommended Soroti Town to become a Permanent Headquarters of Teso Region. Teso then used to comprise of what is now Bukedea, Kumi, Katakwi, Kaberamaido, Amuria and Soroti District. Soroti as Headquarter became a Town Council in the late 1960's and a City in 2020.

Soroti City is located in Soroti County in Soroti District. It lies on latitude 33.38'.East and longitude 1.45' North of Equator. It is 356 km North East of Kampala City. Soroti Municipal

Council is located on Plot No. 14-16 Kennedy Square. It is the third largest town in Eastern Uganda after Jinja and Mbale.
