### ABSTRACT.

This industrial training was done from Kalongo Town Council, located in Northern Uganda for the partial fulfillment leading to the award of Degree in Bachelor in Animal Production and Management. The major objective of the organization is to increase access of the community to proper infrastructure, and high quality human resources and utilization. The purpose of the industrial training was to make student relate theoretical and practical knowledge, and acquaint students with practical skills in handling community based agricultural challenges to improve on the farmer's livelihood. The activities I carried out during the internship include; Ante mortem inspection and Postmortem inspection of slaughter animals; disease management (encompassed: diagnosis, treatment, and vaccination); breeding control exercises (castration, culling and estrus synchronization); farmer training (on disease and parasite management, feeding, breeding, and record keeping) through radio talk shows and physical farmer group discussion; designing and sitting livestock shelters; and animal identification. The internship made me gain practical skills in extension and communication skills; handling equipments for castration, and animal identification; Ante mortem and Postmortem judgments to ensure public health and consumer protection from zoonoses. Furthermore, I learnt more on animal vaccine and drug choices, handling and administration for proper and effective disease control and management, it also acquainted me skills in clinical disease diagnosis and microscopy. However I encountered some challenges during the industrial training of which among include; transport and communication system which limited farmer's access to extension services. And with this industrial training, I will be able to organize and train farmers to improve on their livelihood through agricultural activities. I learnt that teamwork is the best way for successful addressing community challenges. My recommendation to Agago DLG is to enforce animal disease surveillance team and decentralize laboratories for disease diagnosis to some few T/Cs in urge of early disease management.

### CHAPTER ONE

# 1.1 INTRODUCTION

This is a report for the industrial training conducted at Kalongo Town Council, the Department of Production. The report highlights the different activities I engaged in under supervision and guidance of my industrial training supervisor, skills I gained and challenges I face in the course of internship for a period of ten weeks (28th, Febuary 2022 to 6th, May. 2022).

### 1.2 LOCATION

Kalongo town council is located about 15 kilometers north of the district head quarter of Agago district (Agago Town Council), and is bordered to its East extending to its South-West by Parabongo sub-county, to its West is by Kuywee sub-county, and Omiya-pacwa sub-county to its north, approximately 78 kilometers (48miles) south east of Kitgum the nearest large town. It is approximately 155 kilometers (96miles) by road, north east of Gulu City. The coordinates of kalongo, Uganda is 3° 22,400°W. 38° 22, 16.00°E (latitude: 3.04000: longitude: 33.37111);

# 1.3 BACKGROUND OF THE ORGANIZATION

Agago district effective 1<sup>st</sup>, July 2010 was declared a district of its own which was previously Kitgum district. Agago district has sixteen sub-counties including the town councils within the district and this include: Kalongo t/c, Patongo t/c, Agago t/c, Adilang t/c, Omiya pacwa s/c, Parabongo s/c, Paimol s/c, Lamiyo s/c, Lapono s/c, Lira palwo s/c, Omot s/c, Patongo s/c, Wol s/c, Lokole s/c, Kotomor s/c, Arum s/c. Kalongo town council covers approximately an area of 26.43 square kilometers according to the population and household census.

The resident population of Kalongo town council was approximately 11,476 with a total household of 6,098 (2017). The population of Kalongo town council according to UBoS 12,800 (2020 July).
