ABSTRACT

Teso college Aloet farm owned by the school with both animal and crop enterprises that include, cattle, piggery,goat, bananas,forestry, horticulture and other perennial and annual crops planted. It is aimed at providing the school community with high quality animal products and crop produce.

The training at Teso college Aloet provided practical skills, field practice and experience to enhance the theoretical knowledge that is learnt in class. Therefore my objectives were to acquit myself with:

1.0 CHAPTER ONE

1.1 INTRODUCTION:

This report contains and describes the activities that were carried out in TCA school farm

1.2 HISTORICAL BACK GROUND

TESO college Aloet was founded by TESO local government on 9th July 1954.

The foundation stone was laid by the general governor of Uganda, His Excellency sir Andrew Cohen in 1954.

The first school was built using the borrowed funds from Bugisu cooperative Union.In 1956, the college was officially initiated as a junior school (s.1,S.2 and S.3) with 190 students, 31 teachers (mostly whites) and 3 support staff.

However, with the change of the national curriculum in 1985, TESO college Aloet became a secondary school offering classes from S.1to S.4.

The school has got two wings ie East wing (Aloet)and West wing (arapai). These two wings are separated from each other by Soroti Moroto high way.

WEST WING

West wing was formally Soroti technical school, however in 28th Feb 1962,a proposal was brought forward by the permanent secretary, ministry of education and sports to amalgamate it with East wing so as to provide more senior education.

On 1st July 1963, Soroti technical college was emerged as TESO college Aloet West wing having classes of S.1and S.2.

To meet the standards of senior education, some of the buildings were converted to meet this demand.

The tailoring workshop became the junior laboratory

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
