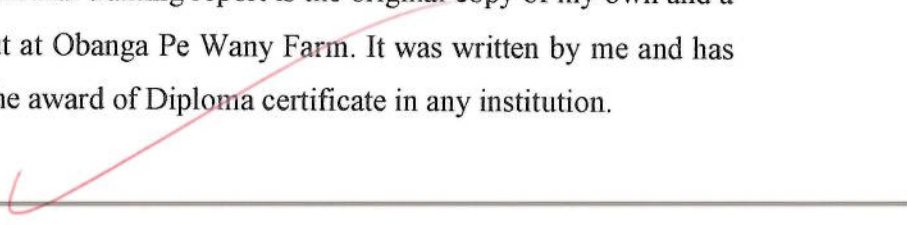

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ABSTRACT

The industrial training was carried out at Obanga Pe Wany Organic Vegetable Farm located in Ireda Shamba Cell, Lira City East Division from 28th Feb 2022 to 6th May 2022. The farm utilizes modern agricultural practices like drip irrigation, baggardening, vertical farming, vermicomposting, air layering and it also offers training to individuals, students and groups of farmers.

During the training I did various activities like air layering, canopy management, hand weeding onions and tomato seedlings, hydroponic fodder making, processing and branding honey, scientific research procedure on tomato seedlings, propagation of banana suckers and many others.
