### **ABSTRACT**

This report is about industrial training that lasted for 10 weeks i.e. from 28<sup>ST</sup> /08/2022 to 06<sup>th</sup> /05/2022 carried out at AGRO MAX (U)LTD Agri-business company Moroto SBDI site located at lokerinyut village, Naduget sub-county, Moroto district, approximately 25 kilometers away from Moroto town west of Moroto district.
