



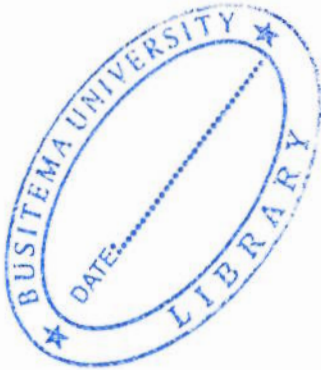

ABSTRACT
