ABSTRACT

The industrial training was done at JEKA poultry farm from the period of 21st may upto 27th of July 2018. The farm mostly deals in production of poultry and poultry products like; eggs, poultry feeds, litter and also one day old chicks, the farm also has set aside horticultural productions.

1.0 CHAPTER ONE

1.1 INTRODUCTION

This training was conducted at Jeka poultry farm between 21st may to 27th July 2018 under the supervision of the instructor Mr. Kaijaniso Bosco. It was based on both animals and crop production and management practices which were conducted successfully.

1.2 HISTORY OF JEKA FARM.

Jeka farm of poultry started in 2007 with 500 birds that was housed in front of the owners' house situated on 50×100 feet plot in kamuli town council.

Because of the inadequate space for expansion, in 2009 farm land was procured in Bukwenge zone – Kamuli Municipality which is in the current location of the farm. On 21st august 2010. Jeka poultry farm was honored to host H.E. Yoweri Kaguta Museveni, the, the president of republic of Uganda.

Since its establishment in 2007, the farm has continued to grow currently having a total of over 25,000 layer birds, in 2011 the farm started piggery section with five gilt out of which one was slaughtered since the pigs have multiplied total of 300 pigs, the steady growth of farm has led to a number of permanent employers from 1-20 on average of 30 casual laborers.

On a monthly basis the farm has introduced a horticulture department which is still intense stage.

1.3 LOCATION OF JEKA FARM.

The farm is located 4kms from kamuli town and 2km off Kamuli Jinja road behind Kamuli Girls boarding primary school.
