#### ABSTRACT

Soroti Government Prison is one of the Government institutions located in Soroti District. It is situated approximately 1km along Soroti - Moroto high way opposite the Flying School. The institution is well known for its key role of safe secure humane custody and re-habilitation of the offenders while placing human rights at the center of their correctional programs. The institution keeps over 7.72 inmates who are under custody and are being re-habilitated and trained in various fields including agriculture. The institution also offers training to other groups of community members who come for learning like intern students. This year, our training covered three key areas of agricultural enterprises like; horticulture, zero-grazing and carpentry work sloop training. Under horticulture, three (3) horticultural crops were under case study, (i.e. onions, green paper and collards). I got good production and management skills starting from nursery bed preparation and management, seed bed preparation, transplanting, weeding, spraying, irrigating vegetables etc. While in carpentry work shop, I learn many things like, different types of work shop tools and their uses, gluing and nailing of wood, sandpapering and vanishing of timbers etc. and under zero grazing unit, I learnt advantages of good hygiene in zero grazing unit, control of external and internal parasite, milking skills etc. Soroti prison is a very good institution for mentoring students because it has got very many good varieties of agricultural activities where student can learn from. On addition to that I also got good leadership skills imparted to me by prison officers.



### CHAPTER: ONE

#### 1.1 INTRODUCTION.

It is the policy of Busitema University to always send its students pursuing diploma in crops production and management to various Organizations dealing in Agriculture related fields such as farm schools, agricultural research stations, Non-Governmental Organizations and any Government institutions dealing in Agriculture related programs through issuing Introductory letters to the concerned stake holders,

In this regard, I have to proceed for my I.T. after completing two years of my course in order to fulfill the university curriculum.

The University's mandate is to ensure that each student after completing one year of the course is to get exposure to the field through interaction with the community through I T. That is where Students can Sensitize, disseminate information learned from school to the farmers at the grass roots, as well as learning from the farmers. In our case, it was because of COVID-19 that is why our intake came for I T after two years. It is expected of each student to compile and write a well-documented report based on facts of findings for the easy assessment and at the same time serves as source of reference to the University.

#### 1.2 REPORTING AND ORIENTATION

Upon receiving my introduction letter, I was offered a place for I.T in Uganda Government prisons Soroti Main, which is within Soroti City. On reaching the Unit, I was received and welcomed by the O.C of Soroti Government prison Mr. JIMMEY ANGUZU. Later, he then took me for orientation and familiarization tour of the Unit, he introduced me to some top administrators of the Unit (CASP and Pos), the staffs, and the prisoners. After that, he then handed me over to the heads of sections (Bed shamba, Zero Grazing and Carpentry work shop) where I toured and got briefing from each in charge. The O. C also briefed me on the rules and regulations governing the Unit, i.e. the "don'ts" and the "do's". He also gave me a brief history of the place which became a stepping stone for me to build my report upon.

## 1.3 BACK GROUND OF SOROTI GOVERNMENT PRISON AND ITS LOCATION.

Scroti Government Prison falls under the institution of Uganda Prisons Service (U.P.S) which is under the Ministry of Internal Affairs currently. Uganda Prisons was formed way back in 1896 under King African Rifle. For the purpose of effective administration, it was decided that the institution be spread the whole country in to smaller units. In this respect, there comes
