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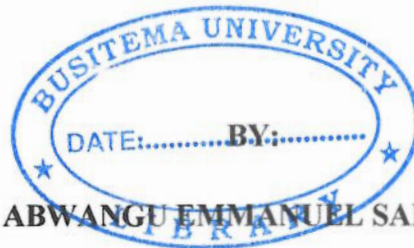

ABSTRACT.

This shows that the entire internship (industrial training) carried out within the school farm of Teso College Aloet was successful. The internship took two months and two weeks within the work station. Chapter one had mainly introduction, objectives of industrial training, back ground, objectives of the school farm, organizational structure of the farm and its location. Chapter two there was orientation on various enterprises that included the following. Crop section; this had a diversity of practices on nursery bed and management that include site selection, primary and secondary tillage, planting of seeds, raising of shade, weeding, drainage mulching, hardening off, planting out, transplanting, and finally harvesting. Animal section; the practices here were overwhelming like meat inspection, castration, paddock establishment, animal health diagnosis and treatment, feeding and feed formulation.
