1.1 Back ground of the organisation.

Uganda Martyrs vocational institution (UMVI) is a catholic church founded institution based in Soroti catholic Diocese. The idea of building up avocational school now called Uganda Martyrs Vocational institution was conceived in 1993. This came as a result of insurgencies in Teso sub-region, which left the community with a lot of orphans, widows, widowers and most of them were left homeless. The primary objective of opening this institution was to equip the youth with vocational skills that would help them to earn a living. (UMVI, then got operational way back in 1996. It started at the diocesan head-quarters in Hilders café and the classroom were from thatched. At a time only three course exist brick laying and concrete practice, motor vehicle mechanics carpentry and joinery.

These learners were offered Uganda formal technical certificate and students were studying four year in the fourth year learners were refastened for final examination with Uganda national examination board and industrial training.

So far the institution has grown has twelve courses both examined at junior level and national certificate

Location; the institution is located 2^{1/2}km along Soroti-Mbale road.
