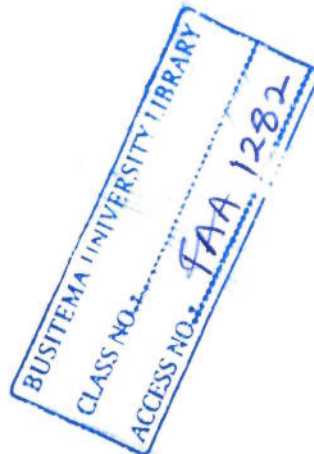

## ABSTRACT.

### Industrial training
