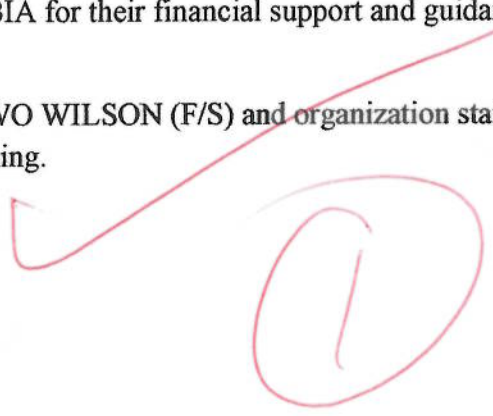

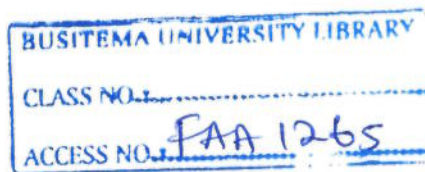

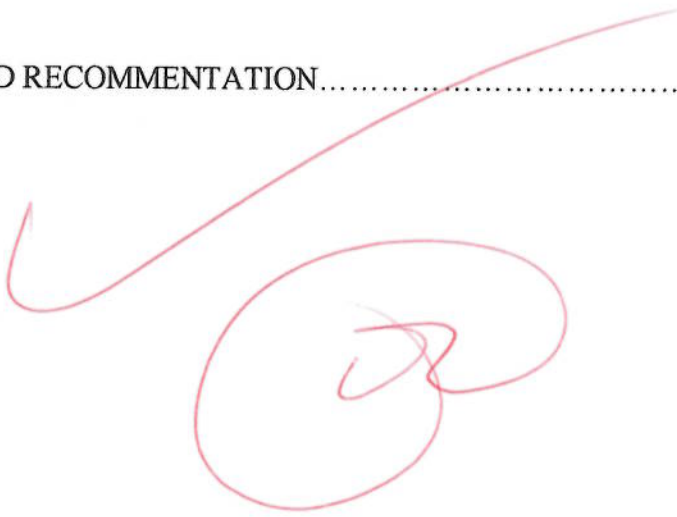

1.0 ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND

AN INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND FOR KAWACOM UGANDA LIMITED

Kawacom is a semi-autonomous private agro industrial company ,a subsidiary organization under the mother umbrella of ECOM trading based in Switzerland with several sustainable management systems(sms) run throughout Africa ,Asia and Latin America, its operates in line with policy guidance of Uganda coffee development authority(UCDA)

The company is composed of chema wet mill and offices as the main station, Sipi, kaserem, kamoko, kibanda, kaproron, masira and tegeres as the main sub stations. Kawacom spear heads in the processing of certified Arabica coffee and exporter of green beans to Europe ,America ,japan and Asia, all this is done with support from the Uganda coffee development authority ,Uganda coffee board and ministry of agriculture animal and fisheries ,the sipi kawacom project comprises of districts Bukwo, Kween, Kapchorwa, Bulambuli and Sironko.

The major beneficiaries of Kawacom are the producer farmers' at large, workers and the students.

1.1 Back ground of the firm

This firm started as a small coffee processing unit under Uganda coffee development authority in 2000 as part of the unit in eastern Uganda to decentralize research on Arabica coffee, import inputs to local farmers and export the processed coffee under the division of ministry of Agriculture. Before funding where received from other support organizations both local and internationally it was getting capital from sale of its products, later international bodies like Taylors of Harrogate international, the Dutch aid and Irish international joined hands in 2009 with kawacom, it was later in 2015 that SOLIDARIDAD came to work with kawacom, majoring research on bananas and coffee production. All products where based on certifications from UTZ certified and Halai control .It became operational in July 2003 majorly based in the eastern part of Uganda where the production of Arabica coffee was high, in 2005, it opened a wet mill in Sipi where farmers where able to sell and process the products of coffee, in 2008 it joined the Rain Forest Alliance certification when it opened a main station at chema where all operations in eastern are carried out
