Welthungerhilfe (WHH) is one of the largest private aid organization German with no politics or religious affiliations. It was founded in 1962 under the umbrella of the UN food and agriculture organization (FAO). Since its inception, welthungerhilfe has implemented overseas projects in over 41 countries. In Uganda, welthungerhilfe started in 1986 making financial contributions and supporting the building of capacities of the local partners. Currently, the Uganda country program has approximately over 130 staffs. The main and coordinating office is located in Kampala, and filed offices in Moroto, Katakwi, Arua, Yumbe, and Fort portal. Welthungerhilfe Uganda programs are implemented in Karamoja region in the district of Moroto, Napak, Amudat, Nakapiripirit; West Nile in the districts of Yumbe and Arua, Teso districts of Katakwi and Amuria; central in the districts of Kampala, Mukono, and Wakiso, Western region in the districts of Kabarole and Kasese

With financial support from the German Federal Ministry for Cooperation and Development (BMZ), WHH is implementing a three-year project titled Protection and Conservation of Lokere Catchment to improve Living Conditions in Karamoja/Uganda in Moroto District and in the Sub-Counties of Rupa, Katikekile and Tapac and Moroto Municipality with local partners in Uganda.
