The Institute was established in 1969, by the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperative and Marketing as a Coffee Research Station known as Buginyanya Coffee Research Station (BCRS), as part of the Coffee Unit at Kawanda to centralize research on Arabica Coffee.

Before the establishment of Buginyanya Station, trials especially Entomology and Pathology were being conducted at farmers' level and Variety Trial Centers (VTCs) well distributed across the districts in areas of: Chema, Kyeminy, Kapchorwa, Busulani, Buginyanya, Bugusege, Bukigai, Bududa and Buwabwala.
