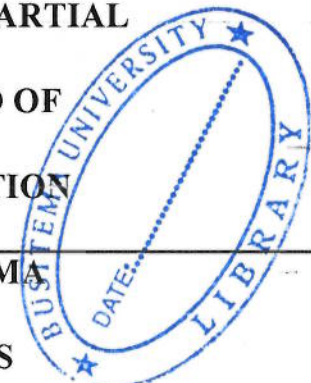



## ABSTRACT

This report is a completion of confirmation about an internship training that was carried out at Rubyerwa dairy investment limited form. This training started on 28<sup>th</sup> Feb 2022 and ended on 06<sup>th</sup> may 2022. RDI Farm is located in Rwanyamahembe Sub County, Kashari County Mbarara District. The Major Objectives of the Industrial training was to acquire practice skills and knowledge about the management of different Agricultural enterprises. It was also aimed at gaining exposure to various activities carried out at Farm level in the Agricultural Production chain.
