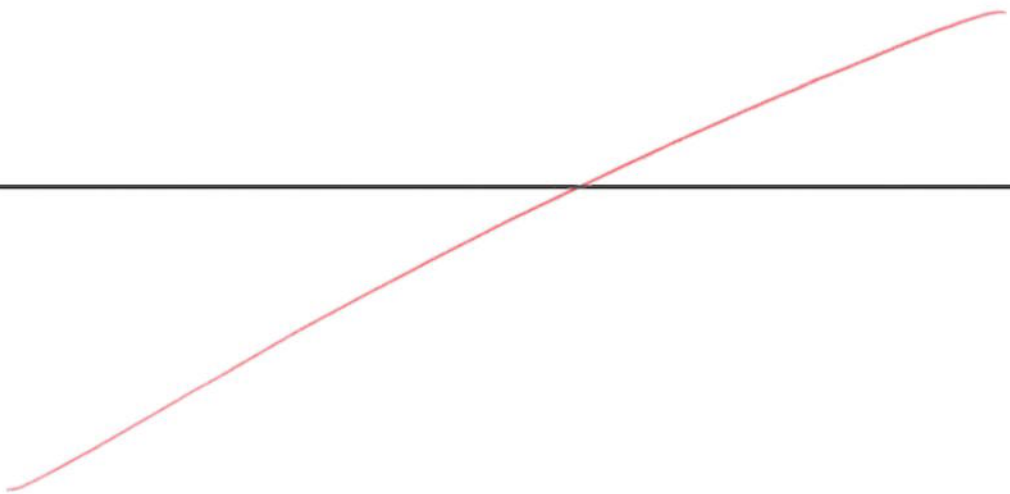

ABSTRACT

Meat inspection at abattoir is one the most important activities in the field of work that I carried out and cannot only be looked, while at abattoir management there were reasons as to why the abattoir staff are failing to perform to their best because of high population of business people that cause congestion, shortage water at the slaughter room, inadequate staff, disease infestations in the animals for the carcass and many others.

CHAPTER ONE

1.0 Introduction

Field work is human service refers to a supervised internship at approved community based on institute/ organisation. This chapter outlines the objectives of institute of the field work placement and institute profile.

1.1.0 Location of soroti district veterinary office

Location of soroti district local government veterinary offices is still found at soroti city after the transition, central cell opposite soroti sports ground.

1.1.1 Historical Background of soroti district local government

The growth of soroti dates as far back as 1904 when the district commissioner of Mbale sent Kakungulu to open up some Administration units in serere, Gweri, and soroti areas. Parts of Kakungulu's team camped near the rock at soroti and settled there. The choice of this site was a camping site and was probably influenced by the availability of good drinking water from a nearby streams and the reality that the rock had some merits in the matter of dams for settlers from the local habitants around under the organised and rule of Kakungulu.

Local inhabitants were forced to clear the forest and within a few days, a large area had been cleared and considerable amount of settlement had taken place. Thatched houses for administrative purposes of soroti county were put, stand and dispensaries in temporally materials stood at the site of present soroti hospital

Later on, with the coming of the Asia traders, small shops in the semi-permanent materials were put in soroti. The trader brought clothes, salt, beads, shoes were traded with exchange for skin, beans, chicken and groundnuts (batter trade).

In 1912 soroti attained the status of permanent headquarters of Teso region as a result of recommendation by sir. Fredrick Jackson after the appointment as the new governor of Uganda.

Later the district commissioner was posted to soroti and then permanent building started to be erected commencing with the district office, however, during the period of first world war (1914-1918), the development was somehow stunted but in 1919 it again picked up.
