ABSTRACT

This report is based on the activities that I carried out in Busitema University, Arapai Campus farm during the period of ten weeks.

The training was based on both animal and crop production and management where I participated in both sections.

The animal section consisted of cattle, rabbits, small ruminants (especially goats) and piggery. While the crop side had perennial and annual crops like maize, bananas, tomatoes, egg plants, green pepper and carrots etc.

I was able to go through all this sections learning a lot of things during each session. Some of the activities that I participated in include training on clean milk production, training on piggery farming, training on rabbit production and management, training on tomato growing, training on apiculture and aquaculture. I also attended a one day seminar on enterprise selection and development and many other activities.
