CHAPTER ONE INTODUCTION

1.0 Introduction

This report describes the activities implemented, skills and knowledge gained, challenges faced during the internship, conclusion of the report and recommendations derived from the challenges faced at Uganda martyrs university farm during the time of industrial training.

1.1Background of Uganda martyrs university farm

Uganda martyrs university farm was formerly called Equator valley farm limited. The farm was established in 1997 to provide sufficient and quality food as well as other value added products such as maize flour and animal feeds to university and outside consumer markets and as well as providing students of agriculture, farmers, researchers, policy makers and business sector with appropriate and applied agricultural production technologies and information for sustainable food production and food security. The farm started as Equator valley farm limited however during the course of time in the mid 2000s, the farm experienced several management challenges as Equator valley farm limited leading to decline in performance.

To this effect, in 2016 an intervention was conducted which involves engagement of consultants to assess the farm and develop a strategic frame work and instrument to be used to have glory of the farm back and serve its original purpose. The intervention was spear headed with the transformation of ownership of the farm from a limited company to management and ownership of Uganda Martyrs University. This was accomplished by buying 100 percent of shares from EVFL. This marked the end of EVFL and beginning of Uganda martyrs university farm.
