Njeru stock farm has an organizational structure right from the manager to the casual workers

Njeru farm has basically the following sections i.e. piggery section where comb rough breed of

pigs are kept and basically these pigs are weaners., secondly goats' section where both exotic

and local breeds of goats are kept that's to say Boer goat, Kigezi goat, east African small goat,

savannah goat, e.t.c. Cattle section where both beef and dairy cattle, local are kept i.e. the Frisian,

Ayrshire, Sahiwal, Ankole and many others

In my training I carried out many activities where we were grouped in certain members working in each section per week and there after rotating in all sections from Monday to Saturday

Knowledge and skills were obtained in many activities like milking, dehorning, treatment, castration, P.D. A.I, flushing e.t.c. Basically dipping was done every Monday and Thursday, milking was done daily every morning and afternoon, bucket feeding of calves every morning and evening after milking and daily monitoring of animals and other activities were random when needed eg. P.D. A.I under guidance and excellent supervision from the field supervisor. However, challenges were faced and that is to say long distances moved when going to the farm every day, High costs of accommodation near the farm etc. I would recommend the introduction of poultry enterprise. Facilitating accommodation to internees at the farm.

1.2 Historical background of Njeru Stock Farm

Njeru Stock Farm was established in 1969 by the government Uganda under MAAIF during Dr Apollo Milton Obote's regime. It Covers covering 750 acres of land.

From 1971 to 1986 the Farm was rooted of its animals due to successive wars that the Farm devastated.

In 1986 during H.E Museveni's regime, there was a restocking program by the government of Uganda.

They imported dairy cattle from abroad, ie Germany and Europe.

In 1999, the Farm was restocked with dairy from western Uganda.

In 2002, the government introduced in Boar goats from South Africa. In 2003, the Cambrough breed of pigs were introduced.

In 2004 the government under MAAIF handed over its supervisory work of the government forms to the body of NAGRC & Data Bank.

1.3 Location

Njeru Stock Farm is located along Kampala – Jinja high way 5km off Nyenga road, Kiryowa village, Njeru south in Njeru Central Division, Njeru Municipality in Buikwe District.

To promote dairy industry by producing enough milk to sustain the population around the community.
