



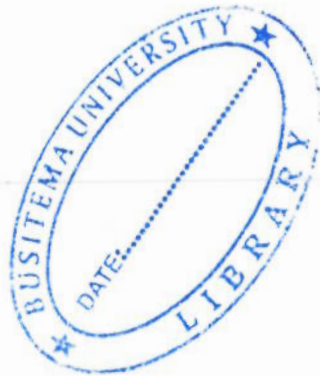



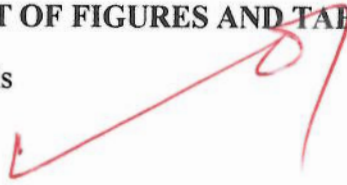

ABSTRACT

This report contains and describes the activities implemented, skills and qualifications gained, challenges faced during the industrial training, conclusion of the report and recommendations derived from the challenges faced at Bukibino Sub-County, Bukibino Sub-County District Local Government. The objective of this industrial training is to make students benefit from the skills and knowledge gained from the fields, apply the knowledge they get from the classroom in the field and build confidence in the students. During internship I was attached to the department of animal production. This was followed by orientation where I was first introduced to the CBFs and later I implemented the activities such as; castration of bulls for fattening. Training of farmers on animal management, animal treatment, vaccination of dogs and cats in all the parishes. These activities has made me to gain a lot of skills and knowledge like; Deworming of goats and cattle, skills in Castration, skills in general management of animals, communication skills and confidence in training farmers on animal and crop management, During internship, I also face some challenges like; poor mobilization of the farmer, lack of veterinary drugs and equipment at the Sub County, limited transport means for field work in the production department and poor turn up of the farmers to the training centers. In conclusion all the activities were implemented and industrial training was carried out successfully. I was able to gain a lot from it. I was in position of getting practical skills and knowledge in line with my career and relating with people in the field. The technical advice that I provided addressed farmers' problem and needs. 1.3 Background of Bukibino Sub-County.

1.3.1 Location and area

Industrial training is the exercise carried out by every institution, university, colleges in order to qualify for the award of certificates, diploma, degree, masters etc.

The purpose of this training is to improve on the practical skills and knowledge for the student.

Under the course of diploma in animal production and management practical. I carried my industrial training in Bududa district Bukibino Sub-County.

The district is bordered by Kenya from the west separated by Mt. Elgon, Mbale from the East, Siroko district from the North and Manafwa from the South. Bukibino is a bout 3km from Bududa district headquarters 71 villages.

The main inhabitants of the constituency is the Gishu who are cattle keepers on zero grazing due to scarcity of land. However few farmers do practice intensive system of grazing.

They mainly keep cross breeds of cattle above 50% exotic, local breeds of pigs and birds.

1.3.2 Political and administrative infrastructure

The Sub-County is under the political leadership of the Lc3 who heads the governing council and the Executives. The Council is the sole decision making body for the Sub-County and its decisions are implemented by the Technical Planning Committee staff from various disciplines headed by the Sub-County Chief. There are 2 Sectorial committees of the Sub-County council each headed by a secretary (executive) namely; Production, Works and Technical Services Committee and Finance, Planning, Administration and Community Services Committee
