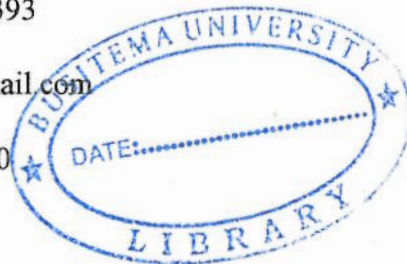

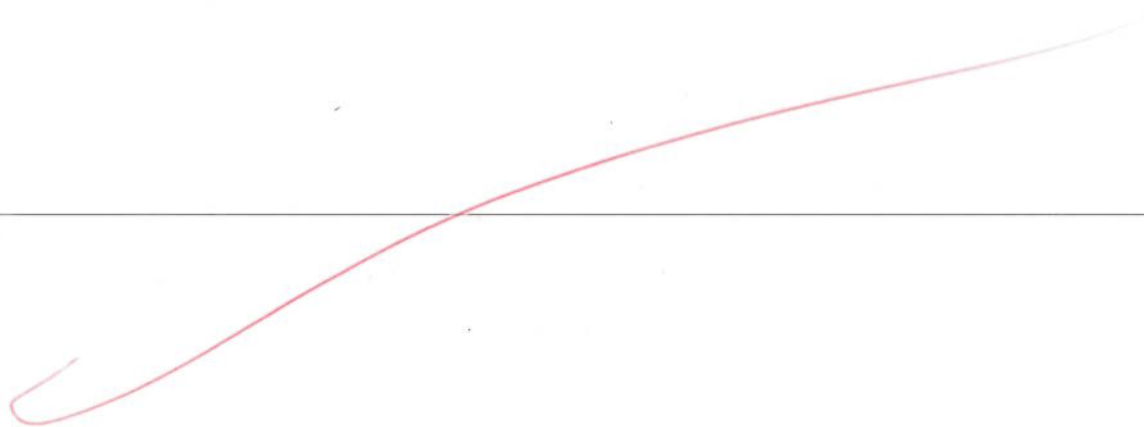



## CHAPTER ONE:

### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 Industrial training

#### 1.3 Back ground of the field attachment.

Teso collage Aloet was founded by the Teso local government on 9<sup>th</sup> July 1954. The foundation stone was laid by the general government of Uganda by his Excellency sir Andrew Cohen in 1954 and in 1956 the college was officially integrated into a secondary school.

The farm started with only two enterprises i.e. dairy and crop enterprises, the diary enterprise had two bulls and five cows while the crop enterprise had one acre of with vegetables.

In 1993 the school had to reestablish its farm with stocking sixteen herds of cattle which were introduced by the Teso restocking project, in same year piggery unit with pigs and poultry unit with two hundred layers were introduced with the funds donated with the WFP.

#### 1.4 Location of the field attachment.

Teso collage Aloet school farm is located in soroti district which is about 7KM north of soroti city along moroto road. The school is divided into two wings the west and east wing where different enterprises are located east wing dominate most of the enterprises while west wing has poultry and part of the crop enterprise.
