HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The historical background states that Ngetta ZARDI has been construction in 1930's during the past World War II period, the institution was used as a resettlement and orientation site for war veterans, in 1930's, the colonial government gave it to the department of agriculture for the purpose of training farmers on the better farming practices. After independence, the government upgraded it to District Farm Institute (DFI) under the ministry of agriculture. Till 1999, when 165 ownership and management changed from DFI to Ngetta Agricultural Research and Development Centre (ARDC), In 2006, the name changed from Ngetta Agricultural Research and Development Institute (ZARDI). The institute has a land of 221hectares (550 acres) while the satellite station has a land of 70.8 hectares (175 acre) though the communities around has encroached some part of the land,

LOCATION.

Ngetta Zonal Agricultural Research and Development Institute (Ngetta ZARDI) is located three miles or 5km on Lira-Kitgum road, North of Lira town in Okii Oyere Village, Telela Parish, Ngetta Sub County, and Lira city east in Northern Uganda.
