ABSTRACT

This booklet summerises all the industrial training activities which I carried out at

Aduku town council under production and marketing department, crop sector, kwania district. I located in North part of Uganda.

The industrial training started from 28/02/2022 to 06/05/2022 with the following activities in the work plan carried out include potting, pruning of coffee plants, pest and disease identification in crops, training on parish development model, distribution of planting materials like seeds, cassava cuttings etc, planting demonstration sites in host farmers field, field visit to farmers operating different enterprises, distribution of seedlings etc, under the supervision of District agricultural officer. With all the activities, much skills, knowledge and qualifications gained which includes gaining practical work in the field which are correlated to theoretical lecture room activities, gaining leadership skills and confidence in communicating in public, training of farmers and interacting with other people etc, however some challenges like long distances, poor roads, and lack of enough transport means to reach farmers, harsh climatic condition like drought, poor turn up of farmers for the training etc, in conclusion, the training went on successfully though some of the recommendation like facilitating enough transport means to extension workers, providing some of the inputs like pesticides to farmers regularly, sensitizing farmers on different modern methods of farming to attain better yields.

CHAPTER ONE: INTRODUCTION

1.0: Background, size and population of Aduku Town Council

In the year, 2007, Aduku township was accorded the status of a town board, it was gazetted to occupy parts of the of parishes of Adyeda and Ongoceng so as to help guide orderly development.

The town council has a total area of 35.6kmsq of which swamps cover 10kmsq and forest reserve cover s 5kmsq.

The town council has a total population of 10,870 where 5090 are males and 5880 females, all these with a total household of 1420. Teduka ward has a population of 6022, with 2771 males and 3251 females and ikwera has a population of 4878 with 2230 females and 2618 males.

1.1: Location

Aduku town council is situated in kwania north county, kwania district, it is in the east of kwania district headquarters, it is engulfed in Aduku sub county.

The town council headquarters is located 35km south of Lira city, Lira, Apac road.

Aduku town council has town wards ie lkwera Ward and Teduka ward. Thirteen cells are to consitute the town council which include. Olami "A", Olami "B", ikwera, Akaidebe and Igura cells (ikwera ward) and Aduku s.s., Aduku u.c.c Akuku town, Adyeda, Alany, Ogobi and Otogole cells (Teduka ward).
