ABSTRACT

The internship was carried out at National Farmers Leadership Centre Kampiringisa. The Centre mainly focuses on citizen's mindset through carrying out a number of trainings in mindset change and transformation and the Saemuel Undong modal of development. The center also set up demonstration projects such as horticulture, mushroom cultivation, livestock in which the participants are trained about the different income generating projects and practices of agriculture.

The internee got involved in a number of activities in all the departments, where new knowledge and skills were acquired. In the mushroom department I was able to acquire new skills in cultivation of the summer oyster mushroom both in the modern way and also growing them locally. Also I leant how to make mycelia from the mother culture using the PDA Potato Dextrose Agar solution.

Livestock department generation of new knowledge on the rearing of pigs in the IMO structure and gained the skill of making the IMO liquid.

In the horticulture activities such as seed sowing, planting, making of seedbeds were carried out in which I participated fully and was able to acquire skills in preparing the soil media for the horticultural crops when making nursery bed for them.

CHAPTER ONE:

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This chapter gives a clear view of the background of the internship placement, objectives goals and mission.

The internship was carried out at National Farmers Leadership Centre for a period of two months where the internee actively participated in number of activities at the Centre.

1.1 Background

The National Farmers' Leadership Centre (NFLC) was established through a memorandum of understanding between the government of the Republic of Uganda represented by the Ministry of Agriculture Animal Industry and Fisheries (MAAIF) and the Republic of Korea Represented by the Korea International Cooperation agency (KOICA).

It was as a result of a visit paid by H.E the president of Uganda to South Korea in 2000 where he got impressed by the approach taken towards development of rural communities of Korea from impoverished society of the 1960s to a modern one through the Saemuel Undong (The New Village Movement) model of development that acted as the magic in the Korean development from a peasantry economy to a modern one in a record period on just one generation.

When the president returned home, he directed and spear headed an initiative to establish a replica Institution of the Saemaul training Centre in Uganda.

National Farmers Leadership Centre (NFLC) was formed based on the Korean model of rural development which focused on citizens' mind-set, the strategy that Transformed Korea society from one of the poorest in the 1960s to be among the 10 largest economies in the world today. The Saemaul-Undong was instrumental in training on leadership, mind-set change and overall social-economic transformation of the Korean rural society during the period of its rapid economic development based on three principles of diligence, self-help and cooperation. In April 2011, Government of Uganda signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Korea Government
