Kaabong district local government (KDLG) Is an association of farmers in kaabong district, registered as local government is operated as a company limited by guarantee without share capital on 1JUNLY 2005 prior to the in cooperation ,KDLG had commenced operation in 2005 as the Kaabong branch of Uganda National Farmers' Association (UNFA) the then National Association for farmers and farmers group, in July 2005,UNFA'S supreme governance organ, the farmers council passed a resolution decentralising it's operation and making it the district branch autonomous entities, the branch was therefore incorporated as companies limited by guarantee without share capital, becoming district farmers association UNFA kaabong branch became kaabong district farmers association (KDFA). The office is located at kampswalli road opposite main offices kaabong production and marketing office c/o box 63 kaabong. KDFA registered a modest growth in membership from 80 members in 2005 reaching 2,680 in 2009. The membership is made up of farmers families and farmers group, the majority of the membership is made up of farmers involve in crop production(65%), with live stock accounting for below(34%) and the remaining (1%) is for beekeepers
