

CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

Ngetta zonal agricultural research and development institute (NGEZARDI) is one of National Agricultural Research Organization located 5km (3 miles) on lira-kit gum road in lira district. Its historical background is scanty, however, inscription on some buildings suggest that the construction at NGEZARDI formally, the District Farm Institute (1964-1998) and Agricultural research and Development Centre (1999-2006) started in 1960's. It was a research center for cotton under the serere research station. During the post-world war II period, the center was used as a resettlement and reorientation site for the war veterans. In the 50's the colonial government gave it to the department of agriculture for the purpose of teaching farmers around the center better farming practices. After independence, the gov't upgraded it to DFI under the ministry of agriculture. And it served Lango district in 1999 its ownership was transferred to National Agricultural Research Organization (NARO). The name then changed from Ngetta DFI to Ngetta Agricultural Research and Development center (ARDC). With the coming force of the NARS Act 2005, Ngetta ARDC became a Zonal Agricultural Research and Development Institute with the main campus at Ngetta in lira district. The ARDC was only operating in two district of lango i.e. Apac and lira but in 2007 under the NARO act of parliament, its name change to ZARDI with a similar mandate itself being autonomous institute under the leadership of director research and governing council i.e. advisory committee,

NGEZARDI carries out also on- station adaptive research trails in collaboration with research institute like NACRI, NALIRRI, national Agricultural research kawanda and national NFIRRI, crop involve in such trails are beans, soya beans, sim sim, ground nut, sweet potatoes, citrus mangoes, fisheries, and livestock research unit are in place and research in aqua culture and goats management is in progress with NALIRRI and NFIRRI respectively
